



BREAKWATER REPAIRS AND DREDGING



Breakwater repairs are on-going or anticipated for:

Milwaukee Harbor, Algoma Harbor, Kenosha Harbor, Kewaunee Harbor, Manitowoc Harbor,
Port Washington, and Sturgeon Bay Harbor.

Dredging for FY 22 included:

Green Bay Harbor, Kenosha Harbor (awarded this summer), and Sturgeon Bay Harbor

Dredging contracts that are anticipated to be awarded in FY23:

Green Bay Harbor and Milwaukee Harbor

Manitowoc/Two Rivers and Kewaunee Dredged Material Management Programs (DMMP)

- Both projects have CDFs that are full
- USACE will be investigating future sediment placement needs and options

- Chamber Floor and Wall Repair has been awarded and work will start this winter
- Estimated completion date April 2024

TJ O'Brien Lock and Dam

- Funded for major rehabilitation
- Work is being scoped and a schedule is being developed

 Replacement of primary and emergency vertical lift gates (FY24)

Soo Lock

-\$1.068B Contract awarded July 1, 2022 Seven years of construction – Summer 2030 \$804M more options may be awarded
